(It is not a requirement that applicants anticipate a career in the dairy industry)

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- 1) Must be a regular or junior member of Holstein Canada, or a son/daughter of a member
- 2) Must have completed at least one year of university or college
- 3) Must have attained a minimum average of 70% in the year of application
(Official transcript must accompany application)
- 4) Must be returning to school within the calendar year

Unsuccessful applicants are encouraged to reapply the following year, if eligible.

AWARDING OF SCHOLARSHIPS

Equal consideration (50%) will be given to:

- 1) Farm background/4-H projects
- 2) Scholastic records/goals

Other accomplishments may influence the selection committee in the event of a close decision.

The winner will be notified immediately upon the selection committee's decision in October.

Official announcement of the awards will be made through the Manitoba Holstein Newsletter and/or the Milkline. Presentation of scholarship will be done at the Manitoba Holstein Branch Annual General Meeting in December.

No individual will be eligible for a second award.
